GUIDELINES FOR A ‘GREEN AWAKENING’ COMMUNITY EVENT

Thank you for your interest in partnering with the Green Awakening Network to hold a ‘green’ event for your community.

Below are the guidelines that the Green Awakening Network has assembled to help you determine if your event may be held under the banner of the Green Awakening Network:

- a. A variety of information is available so that participants might see options to engage their own, personal “next step”.
- b. When possible, an eco-fair is a part of the event.
- c. Ideally, the event engages faith communities other than the United Church and it is planned to be a broad-based, community event.
- d. The event is a platform for other green groups in your community to share information about their work
- e. The event is presented under the GAN banner or that the Green Awakening Network is named as co-presenter of the event.
- f. The logo of the Green Awakening Network, and the City of Toronto’s Live Green Toronto program is included in all promotional efforts.
- g. There is a short speaking opportunity for a representative of the Green Awakening Network to introduce the Network and its objectives.
